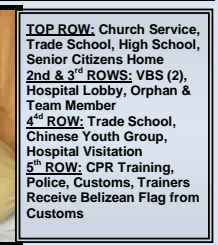

Dear Family and Friends,

In 35 years this has been one of the most exciting times in my ministry. We had three teams at one time. One team (Bonnie and Bobby Steward) taught CPR to the coast guard, police & customs. Two professors from a US Nazarene college brought down another team consisting of college students getting college credit. This team comes down annually and they ministered in the southernmost district of Belize, staying with us when they were in the Belize District studying. And the third team was from Sinking Creek Baptist Church in Tennessee. Their mission focused on evangelism, showing the love of Jesus and sharing the Gospel through puppets, skits, dance, music, VBS, shorts sermons, personal work, church services, and house to house visitation.

The team presented their program to an orphanage, a hospital, two senior citizen homes, four church services, a high school trade school, a Nazarene high school chapel program (close to 400 students in attendance), a Chinese church youth group, and they also conducted two VBSs. The results at the end of nine days: **280 people accepted Christ!**

Now we are doing follow-up and this is so important. We ask your prayers for these 280 – that all will grow daily in God's Word.

Everyone was amazed when, on the spur of the moment, the Lord opened the door for the team to present their program in the lobby of the Belize City hospital and to over 50 security forces personnel of Belize. I have been working with the police for almost three years, telling of their needs both for training and equipment, and working to organize a pilot program for a volunteer police force. I often wondered why I was involved in this. Then, when we brought the CPR team of the Stewards down, the police, coast guard and customs personnel wanted the training also. The one-day CPR seminars lasted from 8 AM to 5 PM for each of the three groups. The team then presented their music and a few skits which really presented the Gospel, followed by a short message by team leader Mark Pierce. When asked if anyone would like to accept Christ, four of the men in the coast guard came forward. The next day the police brought 21 of their staff. Again, when the class was over, we asked the team to present their short program. All 21 members of the class came forward – I've only seen this one other time in my life . . . that was 33 years ago at a small village of 42 people in Belize. They had no church but we wanted to have a service there in their little two-room school building. All 42 came forward and invited Jesus into their lives.



On the third day of CPR training, the customs department sent their officers and the team once again presented their skits at the end of the training. The skits are so real, and a picture is worth more than 1000 words. Seven customs officers received Jesus as their personal savior. All the police, coast guard and customs personnel are adults and leaders in Belize. At the end of their training they each received certificates, but most importantly, most of their names were newly written in the Lamb's Book of Life. Now we are looking forward to our first two-day discipleship training: Friday 2 PM. through Saturday 5 PM. Our visiting speaker/teacher is Rev. Steve Sohns who is flying down from Houston (II Timothy 2:2). This first seminar focuses on the Call of Discipleship and will be using Ray Vander Laan's DVD "In the Dust of the Rabbi." We're offering food and lodging for those who need it. Please see our attachment and we ask for your prayers on this also.
